Events This Term

Whole school Flu Immunisation

After School Club

We will be running an After School Club Monday to Friday up to 4.30pm, provided there are sufficient numbers to make the club financially viable. The school staff will run the clubs Monday through to Thursday with Total Sports running Dodgeball on Fridays (Dodgeball is only be open to Years 1 to 6, excluding Reception).

The After School Club will be £3.00 per session per child **and must booked and paid for in advance of the first session**. Refunds will be offered only if the school has to cancel.

Monday will be games, art, gardening and films. On Tuesday the club will be sport based. Wednesday will be Choir. These clubs are open to the whole school.

Drama will now take place on Thursdays and is open to Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 only and will finish at 5pm.

Staff E-Mails

All e-mails will need to go via the school office, office@chislet.kent.sch.uk, where Ms Campion will distribute to the relevant staff. When the staff reply these will also come to you via the school office.

School Uniform

Please ensure ALL items of clothing are labelled clearly; by doing so we can attempt to ensure that any lost item will find their way back to the right child.

The summer uniform can be worn until the end of Term 1 (Friday 24th October 2025).

Punctuality

The gate will open at 8.40am and then close at 8.50am, anything after this time will be marked in the school register as "Late".

Please note that the order for school meals are phoned in at 9.30am with menu choices, so if your child for any reason, is not in for the morning registration please e-mail the office with their menu choice before 9.30am.

In the afternoon the gate will open at 3.15pm and class will finish at 3.20pm, with the gate closing at 3.30pm.

If your child is going to be absent due to sickness on any day, please ensure you call the school office or e-mail office@chislet.kent.sch.uk by 9.30am in order that an unauthorized absence code is not recorded on your child's attendance.

All absences that are not covered by an email must then be covered with a signed letter from a parent to be handed in when your child returns to school.

Head Lice

It is the school's policy that if a member of staff should see head lice on a child the parents will be called and asked to collect their child in order for them to receive treatment. Children should not return to school until treatment has been carried out.

Lunch Boxes

I would like to remind parents that as a Healthy School we would like to discourage having chocolate bars in lunch boxes.

We are also a nut aware school, so we ask that parents refrain from providing nuts etc. for lunch but if you do include a nut product please make us aware that this is the case.

School Dinners

Caterlink is the provider of the meals for the school. If you have not registered with Caterlink before but would like to do so you will need your child's Unique Number, this can be obtained from Ms Campion. We have been notified that the price of school meals is £3.23 per meal or £16.15 per week.

I have sent a copy of the menu via e-mail in addition to a paper copy.

May I take this opportunity to advise parents/carers that meals must be paid for IN ADVANCE either daily or weekly.

Chislet Community

We are very lucky here at Chislet, our neighbours are all very supportive of the school and will help in so many ways. Bearing this in mind, I would like to stress to all that we must not leave litter in or around the school, the Parish pay for a litter picker and it has been noticed that during the holidays there is less litter around. Please take ALL litter home daily.

In addition I would like to remind parents that when parking please remember not to block our neighbours

driveways, gates or entrances, even if it is a quick drop off or pick up it can be very inconvenient for those who live around the school and **never use the farmyard as a turning point**, Chislet Court Farm is a busy working farm and this is private property.
