We hope you have all had a wonderful Easter and are ready for the exciting summer term.

Our topic until Easter is Passport to the World!

This term is a particularly busy term for our Year 6 children who sit their SATs the week after next. They've worked so hard this year and we know that they will be amazing. Throughout SATs week (Week beginning 11th May) Year 6 are invited to head in to school slightly earlier than usual for a SATs breakfast. We will have a mixture of fruit, pastries and juice as a nice healthy and relaxed start to our days. Year 5 will be taught maths by Mr Huning in the classroom as normal whilst year 6 complete their assessments in the barn.

After SATs, we will begin thinking about our Year 6 leaver's assembly and activities. These events will involve all of Class 4 at times and details will follow shortly.

During the next two terms the class will be focusing on:

English: Completing Firework Maker's Daughter/Kensuke's Kingdom.

Writing: comparative reports, balanced arguments, short stories, commentaries, Letters - formal and informal, Persuasive writing.

Maths: Converting units, Perimeter, Area and Volume, Statistics, Properties of Shape, Position and Movement.

Science: Living things and their habitats/Healthy body healthy mind.

Topic: Passport to the world.

Art/DT: Art from around the globe and Bridges.

RE: Hinduism

Music: Creating a leaver's song

Computing: Artificial Intelligence/Big Data

PE: Athletics/ Dance

PSHE: Citizenship/Financial literacy/Safety and the changing body including Sex and Relationships

MFL: French around the world
