Our intent is to ensure that all children develop a passion for science, understand the role of science in the world in which we live, and also in our own rural community.

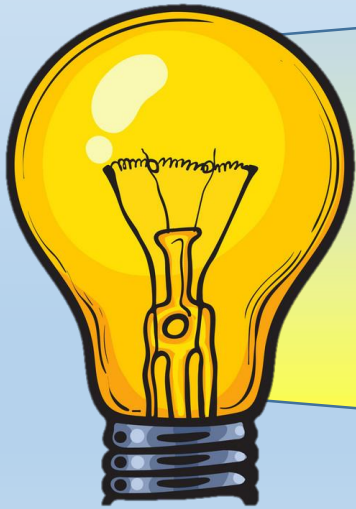
